WHAT CLASSES ARE AVAILABLE FOR PRESCHOOL STUDENTS?



READY SET DANCE is a one hour combo class of JAZZ, TAP, HIP HOP, SINGING and MUSIC. Designed for both boys and girls, the program focuses on teaching the fundamentals of dance while developing confidence, coordination and creativity in a professional and safe environment.

JAZZ – Develop muscle strength, control and balance and achieve coordination milestones like skipping before going to school. HIP HOP – Bust out some ice cold moves just like FREEZE to our original hip hop tracks.

MUSIC – Develop the musical ear, dynamics and tempo while having fun with instruments and the parachute.

SINGING - Sing like TWIRL and build confidence singing on the microphone.

TAP - Learn the fundamentals of tap in a playful and creative way splashing in puddles and shuffling like a penguin.



CAN I PERFORM ON STAGE?

Every child can be part of the Planetdance Annual Concert, which has been, in the past, an excellent performance opportunity for the students and exciting sleek entertainment for the audience. It has also provided every student with stage experience giving an invaluable lesson in self-confidence. The Concert is NOT compulsory but is highly recommended. It's a great way to reward students for their hard work all year. The Date for the 2023 concert is Sunday November 5th, at Sutherland Pavilion Performing Arts Centre. Be sure to save the date and invite your family to watch your student shine.

COSTUME AND CONCERT LEVIES

Costumes play an enormous part in portraying themes and give the students the magical stage experience of their dreams. Students partaking in the Concert will require one costume per Concert class they participate in. Our trained staff take care of the sizing and organising of costumes, making the experience completely stress-free. We will take care of the measuring and style selection based on what we see as most appropriate to the style or theme of the routine. We will size the costume to fit for the day of the Concert, ensureing everyone looks their best.

A costume levy will be paid for each class performed in the Concert. This is a lay-by system for your child's costume/s so that you can budget and pay off in small manageable increments. Costume levies are payable at the same time as class fees in Terms 1, 2 and 3. Acrobatics does not incur a costume levy.


Levy amount invoiced for Ready Set Dance and Ready Set Ballet students who start in Term 1 \$37.00 per concert class for Terms 1, 2 and 3.

Students starting in Term 2 will pay the 1st and 2nd instalment and Students starting in Term 3 will pay the costume amount in full.

While it's not compulsory, it is assumed all students will be participating in the end of year concert. Parents must advise us in written form if their child is NOT performing at the concert by the close of business (9pm) 17th July 2023.

If you advise us prior to the 17th of July 2023 you will be entitled to a credit of all levies paid. If advised after the 17th of July 2023 parents will become liable for the full cost of the costume. In the case of cancelled enrolment or deferment or notice that your child/ren will not be attending concert for any reason after 17th July 2023, please be aware that the costume levy will not be refundable or

transferable. If a student's parent or carer fails to pay the required costume levy or any other outstanding charge on their account, no costume will be provided and the student will be unable to perform in the concert.











DIGITAL CONCERT COSTS

Each student participating in the concert will be invoiced for Digital Concert Costs in Term 4. This cost includes the copyright licence fee for each child and the cost of producing and editing the footage and is expected to be between \$38-\$40 depending on the licence fees at the time. Every parent will be provided with a link to download the concert to keep forever! This link can be shared with family and friends however due to music licence and child protection laws, concert routines cannot be shared or uploaded on any social media or public platform (including but not limited to: Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube etc).



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I watch my child's classes?

In our experience preschoolers are able to concentrate better without the distraction of other noise in the room from parents and other siblings. Our program has been endorsed by leading child care experts who support the independent learning model. As preschoolers participate in classes they have the opportunity to develop additional secure attachments with adults (teachers) and peers. This helps them transition positively into the larger world and helps with school readiness.

Having said that, a lot of children are timid at first and need to know that a parent is close by. You're more than welcome to wait while you child takes their first class

Are your teacher's qualified?

All teachers have their Working with Children Check and follow the program that is endorsed by early learning experts.

Do we need to purchase uniform and shoes?

Students must wear the READY SET DANCE uniform. However, we need to make sure we are the right fit for you and your child before committing to anything. Comfortable clothes and sneakers are fine for the first couple of lessons. Once your child has settled you can purchase the official READY SET DANCE uniform at reception which we are sure you will love.

If we miss a class can it be made up on another day of the week?

You may swap days during Terms 1, 2 and 3 if you miss a class (as long as the make up class is not full). In term 4, each class works on a different routine for the end-of-year concert, and it is too confusing for students to be swapping days. We do recommend that you avoid alternating days too much as preschoolers need the comfort of knowing that the same teacher and their friends will be there when they go to dancing.

Does my child need to participate in the concert?

This is not compulsory but highly recommended. It's a magical day that creates memories that last a life time, so the majority of students love to participate in this annual event. More information regarding the concert can be found later in this information pack.

Planetdance Policies and Procedures

Recreation & Pre School Classes

Fees

- Invoices will be issued prior to the commencement of each term, with the due date being at the end of week two. Any student who enrols mid-term will receive their invoice within one week of enrolment and be given a two-week payment term. All invoices will be emailed.
- Payment Term payments are required. Fees are to be paid for in advance and are nonrefundable. Term fees are paid via AUTO PAY or at Reception. Surcharges will apply to all EFTPOS payments and credit card payments. Current surcharge amounts are displayed at Reception. All accounts must be finalised by the due date of each account, or a late fee will be payable. Please be reminded that only with the fulfilment of financial commitments by everyone can Planetdance continue to provide first-class tuition for all students at a competitive price structure.

Should a payment fail, a dishonour fee will be payable. Auto Pay Terms and Conditions are at the end of this Information Pack.

Any overdue accounts will be passed onto a debt-collecting agency. Planetdance reserves the right to pass on to the client all fees and charges incurred as a result of the recovery process.

- Registration An annual non-refundable registration fee of \$39.00 per student must be paid fee prior to the first lesson to cover administration costs, intellectual property fees for music & insurance.
- Credits & Overhead costs continue regardless of how many students attend classes, Refunds therefore, there are no refunds for classes not attended. Credits and refunds will not be issued due to missed classes, illnesses (including COVID), school events or holidays, or if you choose not to return during the term for any reason fees cannot be transferred to another student or family member. In the case of a serious illness of more than 4 weeks, fees may be credited to another term within the current year of enrolment (medical certificate must be presented as proof). Credits will only be applicable during the registered year. Registration fees are non-refundable for any reason.

Auto Pay

Auto Pay is our preferred payment method. Registration into Auto Pay is compulsory. However, there will still be other methods of payment available. For more information, read through these FAQs:

Q. Is Auto Pay compulsory?

A. Yes, it will be compulsory for all students to be registered for Auto Pay

Q. Are there alternate payment methods?

A. Yes, you can still make payments at Reception by cash or card. If your account balance is \$0.00, Auto Pay will not deduct any funds from your nominated card.

Q. What dates will Auto Pay run?

A. Auto Pay will run on the due date of each transaction. We will send reminders for Term fees; however, it will be your responsibility to ensure funds are available regardless of whether you have received a reminder.

Q. Will we still receive statements?

A. Absolutely. Our usual routine of sending statements before the term will continue as normal. You will have ample time to review your statement before the payment being deducted from your card.

Q. Can I set up a Payment Plan to be deducted weekly, fortnightly or monthly?

A. YES! Once you have registered for Auto Pay, you can request a set amount to be deducted from your account either weekly, fortnightly or monthly. However, please note that anyone on a payment plan will not be entitled to the 20% Multi-Class Discount.

Q. Is there a surcharge?

A. Yes, a 1.75% surcharge + \$0.30 per transaction is charged by DSP Merchant Services, which will be passed onto you at the time of the transaction.

Q. Are my credit card or debit card details safe?

A. DSP Merchant Services is managed by Stripe – one of the largest financial services software companies in the world. Stripe uses the most stringent levels of certification available in the online payments industry. Neither we (Planetdance) nor our software provider (DSP) can see your full credit card details, and they are fully encrypted by Stripe.

Q. How do I set it up?

A. Enrolling in Auto Pay can be done at the studio by the administration, or it can be set up through your online parent portal on Dance Studio Pro.

Q. Where can we read the Terms & Conditions?

A. Terms and Conditions are outlined on the Parent Portal, which you must read and agree to before registering your card details. If you have any specific questions, you can call our Studio on 0456 778 867 during business hours.
